The new officer will need clothing for PTI training. Chief Wade will take Jackson Bugg to Danville to get the necessary equipment for the academy. Jackson will need sworn in.

Mayor Page was called from Brick's Exquisite Eats about possibly getting a mobile liquor license. Mayor Page will discuss with the attorney. They do not currently have a liquor license.
