

STREETS COMMITTEE MEETING

March 8, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Reed at City Hall.

Streets Committee members present were Chairman Reed, Nelsen and Smith. Also present was Mayor Page, Street Supt Darin Damery, Treasurer Angel Palmer and City Clerk Janet Waller.

Aldersperson Smith made a **motion to approve the Streets Committee Meeting Minutes of February 9, 2021**, seconded by Aldersperson Nelsen. Motion carried with Aldersperson Reed, Smith and Nelsen voting aye and 0 nays.

Under Old Business:

Adult Easter Egg Hunt will be held on April 9th. Barricades will be needed on First and Second Street on Oak Street.

Under New Business

Concrete sidewalks will be done this summer. The businesses on Chestnut Street will be notified when work will start.

The railroad on First Street needs to be repaired. Mayor Page has discussed the issue with the railroad.

Street Supt Damery discussed the prices of mosquito spray. There may be a possibility of purchasing last years mosquito spray at a lower price than this years. The committee approved agreed to go ahead and purchase last year's mosquito spray if it is still available.

Street Supt Damery has started a list of trees that need to be removed. There is also trees on the highway that will need to be trimmed. The committee agreed on using the same contractor as last year.

The committee discussed the upcoming oiling and rocking. It was discussed the price of oil last year was \$240 a gallon and has increased to \$310 this year so far. The price of rock will be \$11,500 and the Street Supt would like to purchase it in April.

Aldersperson Nelsen made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:47 pm.
