The approximately price for the rock for the streets will be \$15,000.00. Council Member Smith, seconded by Council Member Walden, made a **motion to approve \$15,000.00 for the rock for the streets.** Motion carried with Alderpersons Nelsen, Smith, Reed, Walden and Workman voting aye and 0 nays.
