The committee would like to create buffers between the home next door to the park by planting trees.

Littering signs and surveillance signs will be put up at the park.

The committee went over the budget. The park will get \$18,000.00 from the ARPA allocation for revenue replacement.

The committee agreed to advertise for donation of trees to the park and discussed possibly plaques in memory of loved ones.
