

STREETS COMMITTEE MEETING

Under New Business

They will be oiling and rocking in the near future.

Mayor Page has purchased lights for the signs on Rt 51. They will arrive in 10 weeks and Greg Butcher will install the lights.

Mayor Page announced Travis Sullivan is interested in the Aldersperson vacancy for Ward 2 and would like to appoint him at the July Council meeting.

Mayor Page would like to change the meetings to 2 meetings a month. One meeting would be an ordinance meeting to go over everything and then a council meeting would still be on the first Wednesday of the month. The committee discussed their thoughts.

Public comments questioned if a sidewalk or a bike path could be put in for the safety of people walking to Dollar General. Street Supt Damery is working on engineering and getting possible plans for a sidewalk.

Aldersperson Reed made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:50 pm.
