# AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY INTO THE MUNICIPAL TERRITORY OF THE CITY OF ASSUMPTION, CHRISTIAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS,

WHEREAS, a voluntary Petition to Annex Certain Territory to the City of Assumption (the "Petition for Annexation") has been presented to the City Council of the City of Assumption, Christian County, Illinois, by John Holthaus and Julie Holthaus, to annex certain property that is contiguous to the existing boundaries of the City of Assumption; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the Petition for Annexation, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and,

WHEREAS, notices of hearing on the proposed annexation have been sent to public bodies in accordance with Illinois statute; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Assumption has determined that the Petition for Annexation is in conformance with the goals and objectives of the City of Assumption; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Assumption has determined that the proposed annexation will not negatively affect the City of Assumption and would be in the best interests of the City of Assumption and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ASSUMPTION, CHRISTIAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Petition for Annexation, attached as Exhibit A and hereby incorporated for reference, is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance herein approved with the Recorder of Deeds of Christian County, Illinois.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall cause a copy of this ordinance to be published in pamphlet form for 10 days after its passage and approval.


