### WATER/WASTEWATER COMMITTEE MEETING

## **August 15, 2023**

Meeting called to order at 6:39 p.m. by Alderperson Walden at City Hall.

Water Committee members present were Alderpersons Donny Walden, Travis Sullivan and Ross Workman. Also present was Mayor Derek Page, Water Supt Jack Duncan, Water Collector Tanya Rhoades and City Clerk Janet Waller.

Present in the audience was Ron Legner from Chastain and Associates.

Alderperson Sullivan made a motion to approve the minutes of August 18, 2023 Water/Wastewater Committee meeting minutes, seconded by Alderperson Workman. Motion carried with Alderperson Workman, Walden and Sullivan voting aye and 0 nays.

### **NPDES Progress Report:**

The NPDES permit needs renewed before July 1, 2024 and we need to apply 180 days before it expired. Engineer Ron Legner continues to work on the renewal process.

#### **Under Old Business**:

The new service truck will be here in September. City will need to purchase a plow package, power tools and a generator for the new truck.

#### **Under New Business**:

A hydrant will be purchased with funding left from the ARPA Samuel Street.

The committee discussed the generators and will look into it further in the future.

Petersburg Plumbing will be starting to work again on Sanitary Sewer Phase 2. There maybe 4 crews coming to work.

Water Employee Dana will start working with the reporting process to keep records up to date such as flow reports and monthly operator reports.

Mayor Page thanked Water Supt for helping with cleaning up storm damage. Moweaqua and Ramiro were also helping with the cleanup.

Engineer Ron Legner informed the committee they continue to work on the Water Treatment Plant progress.

Clerk Waller will check the status of the Lead Service Line Grant.

Water Supt would like to check into 120 Water Solutions in conjunction with Chastain and Associates.

Water Supt updated the committee on lead lines and compliance dates.

Alderperson Walden noted the retention pond at GSI has had water in it after the last couple of heavy rains.
